



This workshop will “unpack” the essay format and provide participants with the opportunity to identify and manipulate the various elements of the essay. Essays related to text analysis as well as information delivery will be addressed. The technique for structuring essays will come from two approaches – firstly the macrostructure where large-scale variables will be considered and secondly the microstructure where devices to facilitate cohesion and increase links between ideas will be investigated.

The workshop will be a practical session where participants can contribute their own ideas and discuss written expression difficulties experienced by the children they are teaching.

Presenter:

Jenny Baker is a speech pathologist who works at Fremantle Speech Pathology Services. She works exclusively with children and young adults who experience reading, writing and spelling difficulties. She has a passionate interest in devising explicit teaching tools to explain the rules and regulations governing the English language system so that children can “crack the code” no matter what level of text they are expected to deal with.
