

Words are made up of meaningful parts called morphemes and an understanding of morphology assists students with spelling, reading comprehension and written expression. It is also important to develop an understanding of etymology, particularly as over 60% of the words used in upper-primary and secondary school texts are of either Latin or Greek origin. Students need to acquire a very basic working knowledge of both Latin and Greek word structure, and the spelling conventions linked to these two languages, if they going to read well and spell accurately.



In this workshop Latin, Greek and Anglo-Saxon morphemes will be examined and a number of very practical (and enjoyable) classroom activities trialled. Ideal for teachers of middle- primary, upper-primary and secondary school.

Presenter: Mandy Nayton is currently the Executive Officer of DSF Literacy and Clinical Services. She is a practising psychologist and qualified teacher with extensive experience in the field of educational and counselling psychology. Mandy assesses children, teenagers and adults struggling with the acquisition of effective literacy skills and recommends appropriate classroom-based and individual strategies. She also runs numerous courses on literacy acquisition and learning difficulties both for DSF and in association with the University of Western Australia's Child Study Centre.
