



# Interactive Workshop

## Getting the most out of your Interactive Whiteboard

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Easiteach is a software program designed to maximise the learning opportunities possible by having an Interactive Whiteboard in the classroom.

This full day workshop will be split into two sessions: An introductory session in the morning, which is optional to attend for those who are familiar with Easiteach, and an advanced interactive session in the afternoon, for all Easiteach users.

In the **introductory workshop in the morning**, the basic features of the Easiteach program will be demonstrated. Participants will also see how the software allows teachers to construct motivating and engaging lessons with a particular emphasis on multi-sensory aspects.

The introductory workshop is suitable for teachers and administrative staff who do not have an Interactive Whiteboard in their school and wish to find out more about this effective teaching strategy, and also for educators already using the whiteboard who are keen to improve their knowledge of Easiteach.

In the **advanced afternoon workshop** participants will build on the knowledge gained in the Intro to Easiteach workshop, the morning session of this workshop, or from previous personal experience with the software, with an advanced interactive session using the software.

The advanced workshop is designed for teachers who have experience with the basic functions of Easiteach and wish to explore advanced techniques and ways of using Easiteach for literacy instruction in the classroom.

**Target Audience:** Classroom teachers (all year levels), Special Needs Teachers, Literacy Support Teachers, Language & Special Needs Advisors, Speech Pathologists, School Psychologists and interested parents.

**Presenters:** *Kelly Fullarton is a Psychologist at DSF Literacy and Clinical Services. She assesses children, teenagers and adults struggling with acquisition of effective literacy skills and recommends appropriate classroom-based and individual strategies.*

*Gemma Boyle is a Psychologist at DSF Literacy and Clinical Services where she assesses children and adults with learning difficulties and disabilities. She also consults with parents and educators regarding the nature of Specific Learning Disabilities and how to improve literacy outcomes. Gemma is keen to maintain the link between theory and practice in order to provide evidence-based strategies for those experiencing literacy difficulties.*
