

Evidence-based computer program for students struggling with literacy – an interactive workshop

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WordShark combines the excitement of computer games with the serious task of learning to read and spell and offers over 55 different games which use sound, graphics and text to teach and reinforce word recognition and spelling.

This workshop takes participants through the many features of the **WordShark (Version 4)** computer program from both a teaching and student management perspective. This is a hands-on, interactive workshop providing teachers with ample opportunity to practise the skills that they are learning.

Participants will learn how to: select appropriate games and word lists to meet their students needs; edit and create their own word lists; program individual or class lesson plans; create offline activities; and, record and monitor students' progress. **(Note: Max 16 participants)**

Target Audience: Classroom teachers (all year levels), Special Needs Teachers, Literacy Support Teachers, Language & Special Needs Advisors, Speech Pathologists, School Psychologists and interested parents.

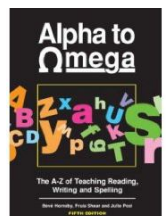
